His most recent publication is the first-ever English translation of St Maximos the Confessor: On Difficulties in Sacred Scripture. The Responses to Thalassios (Washington, D.C., 2018). His work focuses on the patristic and Byzantine theological tradition, the patristic interpretation of Scripture, the Philokalia and Orthodox spirituality, and the theological study of Byzantine art, icons and iconography.


>Things to Bring <

All services will be at the monastery. Appropriate clothing for the monastery includes long pants and sleeves.


